FATHER, from all you give us we present this bread and wine. As we serve you now, accept our offering and sustain us with your promise of eternal life.

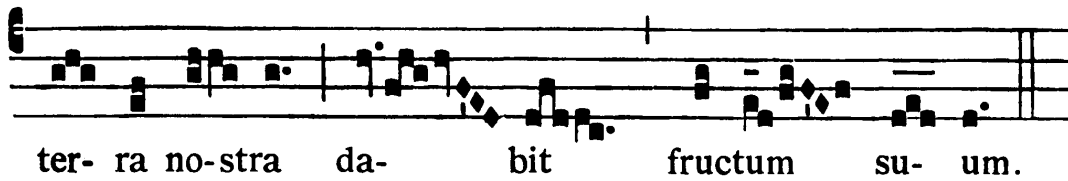
