CHRISTMAS CYCLE: THE INCARNATION

Advent

November 27 to December 24.

- V 1st Sunday of Advent, 1 cl. sd. (*the Sunday nearest to the feast of St. Andrew.*)
- V 2nd Sunday of Advent, 2 cl. sd.
- V 3rd Sunday of Advent, 2 cl. sd. (Also rose vestm.)
- V Ember days (Wednesday, Friday and Saturday after the 3rd Sunday of Advent.)
- V 4th Sunday of Advent, 2 cl. sd.

Christmastide

December 24 to January 13.

- V Christmas Eve, vigil of 1 cl.
- W CHRISTMAS DAY, d. 1 cl. with priv. oct. of 3rd ord.
Commemoration of St. Anastasia at 2nd Mass.
- W Sunday within the octave of Christmas, sd.
- W Circumcision of our Lord Jesus Christ, and octave of Christmas, d. 2 cl.
- W The Holy Name of Jesus, d. 2 cl. (*Sunday after the Circumcision, or Jan. 2, when there is not a Sunday between the 2nd and 5th inclus.*)
- W Vigil of the Epiphany, 2 cl. sd.
- W EPIPHANY of our Lord Jesus Christ, d. 1 cl. with priv. oct. of 2nd ord.
- W 2nd day within the octave of the Epiphany, sd.
- W 3rd " " " " " " " sd.
- W 4th " " " " " " " sd.
- W 5th " " " " " " " sd.
- W 6th " " " " " " " sd.
Com. of St. Hyginus, P. M.
- W 7th day within the octave of the Epiphany, sd.
- W Sunday within the octave of the Epiphany: The Holy Family, gd. (with the same privileges as a 2 cl. Sunday.) Com. of the Sunday.
- W Octave day of the Epiphany, gr. d.

Time after Epiphany

Jan. 14 to Septuagesima Sunday.

- G 2nd to 6th Sunday after Epiphany, sd. (*The 3d, 4th, 5th and 6th Sundays after Epiphany are movable and may be kept after the 23rd Sunday after Pentecost according as Septuagesima comes early or late in the year.*)

 V | 4th " " " 1 cl. sd. (*Also rose vestments.*)

 W | Feast of the Seven Sorrows of the Bl. Virgin Mary, gd. (*Friday in Passion week.*) Com. of the feria.
 V | Palm Sunday, 1 cl. sd.
 W | Maundy Thursday, d. 1 cl.
 B | Good Friday, d. 1 cl.
 VW | Holy Saturday, d. 1 cl.

Paschaltide

- W | EASTER SUNDAY, d. 1 cl. with priv. octave of 1st order. (*March 22 to April 25.*)
 W | Easter Monday, d. 1 cl.
 W | Easter Tuesday, d. 1 cl.
 W | Wednesday to Saturday in Easter Week, sd.
 W | Low Sunday, gr. d.
 W | Solemnity of St. Joseph, C. Spouse of Our Lady, Patron of the Universal Church, d. 1 cl. with a common octave. (*Wednesday after 2nd Sunday after Easter.*)
 W | Octave day of St. Joseph, gr. d. (*Wednesday after 3rd Sunday after Easter.*)
 V | Rogation days (*Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of the 5th week after Easter.*)
 W | ASCENSION of our Lord Jesus Christ, d. 1 cl. with priv. octave of 3rd order. (*Thursday after the 5th Sunday after Easter, April 30 to June 3.*)
 VR | Vigil of Pentecost, 1 cl.
 R | PENTECOST, d. 1 cl. with priv. octave 1st order (*May 10 to June 13.*)

- R Monday and Tuesday of Pentecost, d. 1 cl.
R Wednesday, Friday, Saturday, Ember days of Pentecost.

Time after Pentecost

- W Trinity Sunday, d. 1 cl. and 1st after Pentecost.
(*May 17 to June 20.*)
W CORPUS CHRISTI, d. 1 cl. with priv. octave of
2nd order. (*Thursday after Trinity Sunday.*)
W Sunday within the octave of Corpus Christi, sd.
W THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS, d. 1 cl. with
privileged octave of 3rd order. (*Friday after the
octave of Corpus Christi.*)
W Sunday within the octave of the Sacred Heart, sd.
G 4th to 23d Sunday after Pentecost, sd.
V Wednesday, Friday and Saturday after Sept. 14,
the Ember days of September. (*In the Missal, be-
tween the 17th and 18th Sunday.*)
G 3rd to 6th Sunday after Epiphany, according as
Easter is early or late, sd.
G 24th Sunday after Pentecost, sd. (*The last Sunday
before Advent.*)
